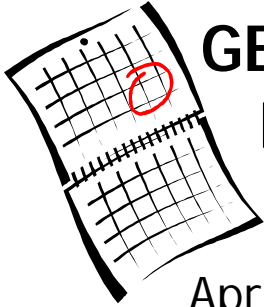

Neighborhood Conservation Projects

The Neighborhood Conservation (NC) program provides County funds to conserve and improve neighborhoods in Arlington County. Our current NC project is the extension of the median on Williamsburg Boulevard, between Trinidad & Westmoreland Streets, which is scheduled to begin shortly. The next projects awaiting approval are (1) sidewalk construction for 26th Street between Quantico and Potomac Streets and (2) a streetlight project to replace the existing cobra-style lights with Carlyle-style lights for 26th and 27th Streets between Underwood and Westmoreland Streets.

New Traffic Lights

At the request of the AEFCCA, a new traffic light is now being installed at Sycamore and 26th Streets, near Tuckahoe Elementary School. Also, a new traffic light at Lee Highway and Westmoreland Street has been fully funded. The AEFCCA is working to have the light installed prior to completion of the WestLee project.

Westmoreland Street Revitalization Continues

The Easton Site Plan and rezoning for the Tax Analysts site (behind the Econolodge, between Westmoreland Street and Fairfax Drive) was approved by the County Board in November 2005. A 214-unit condominium with first floor retail space will complement the nearly completed WestLee development project across Westmoreland Street. The Plan includes a one-acre park on what is today Fairfax Drive.
