**EFC Task Force Public Hearing**

The East Falls Church Planning Study Task Force will hear public testimony on future plans for the neighborhood at Tuckahoe Elementary School at 7:00pm, January 23, 2008. The Arlington County Board appointed the 18 member group last summer "to generate a vision for transit-oriented development in the East Falls Church area." According to Task Force Chair and AEFCCA President Mike Nardolilli, the group would like to hear how the public envisions East Falls Church 10 to 20 years from now, including their views on land use, transportation and other issues. The Task Force will review planning efforts such as the AEFCCA Metro Survey (2005), the Virginia Tech East Falls Church Metro Area Plan (2004) and the Washington Metropolitan Area Transit Authority Station Access Study (2002). Beginning February 27, 2008, the Task Force will hold monthly public meetings at Fire Station #6 (6950 Little Falls Road) at 7:00pm on the fourth Wednesday of each month. Learn more at:
