**East Falls Church Planning Study Task Force
Moving Forward**

The 19-member Task Force, appointed by the Arlington County Board two years ago, has been reviewing existing development plans and collecting new data. Its objective is to "generate a vision for transit-oriented development in East Falls Church". It represents the first comprehensive planning review for our neighborhood in 25 years and will establish important new guidelines for future development. Later this Fall, the Task Force will begin drafting recommendations that will likely include a new western Metro entrance, height and density limitations on and around the Metro site, and streetscape improvements. A draft plan should be ready for presentation to the AEFCCA by the January 2010 General Membership meeting.

Upcoming Task Force meetings are scheduled for September 23rd, October 28th, November 18th (tentative) and December 16th (tentative) at 7:00pm at Fire Station #6 on Lee Highway across from the Bear Rock Cafe.
