County Board Member Chris Zimmerman will be the featured speaker at the next general membership meeting of the Arlington East Falls Church Civic Association. Chris has been asked to speak about the appointment of the East Falls Church Task Force (see accompanying article) and development in and around the East Falls Church Metro stop.

County Appoints

East Falls Church Task Force

During this past summer, the Arlington County Board appointed a 17-member East Falls Church Task Force “to generate a vision for transit-oriented development in the East Falls Church area of Arlington County.”

The County Board designated Mike Nardolilli, President of the Arlington East Falls Church Civic Association (AEFCCA), to head the group. The County Board also appointed AEFCCA representatives John Wilson, Alan Parker, and Tim Reese, with Barbara DePauw as an alternate. The rest of the Task Force is composed of representatives of other civic associations, County advisory groups, the City of Falls Church, Metro and VDOT.

The Task Force is charged to review all previous planning efforts, specifically including the AEFCCA Metro Survey completed in 2005, and report directly to the County Board.

The Task Force plans on holding monthly public meetings at Fire Station #6, which is located on Lee Highway/Washington Street in the neighborhood. The Task Force held its first organizational meeting on September 26th. Additional information can be found at the following website:

- Within ½ mile from a school or Metro, bus or ART stop

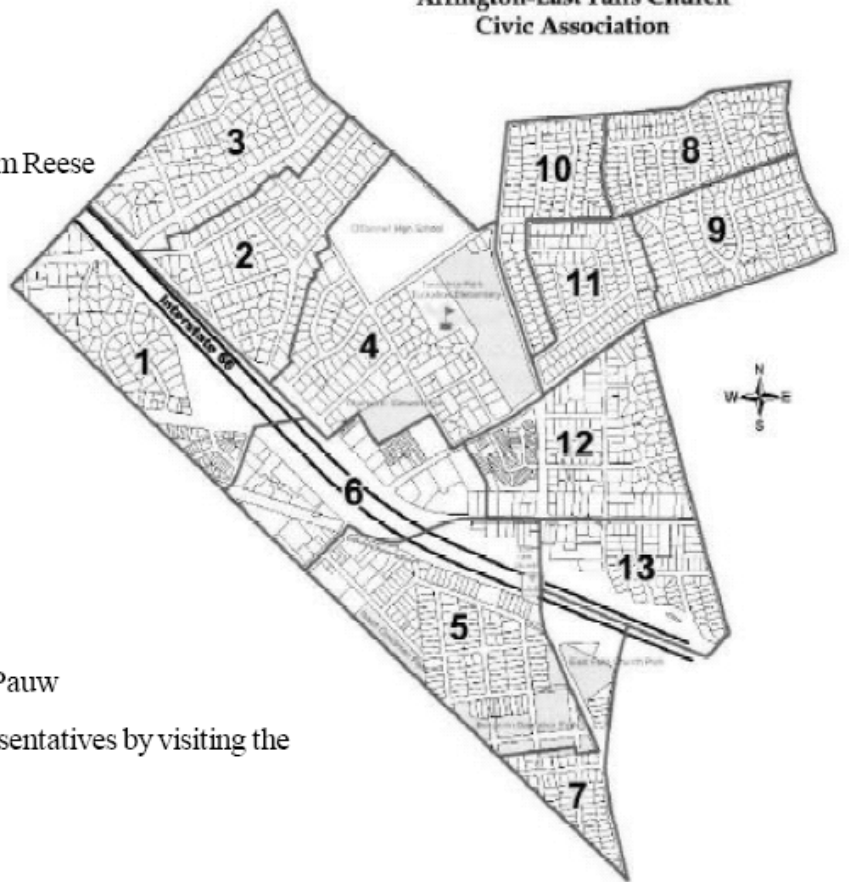
