Pedestrian Street Lights **LEARN ABOUT LED LIGHTING**

Would you like to learn more about the Arlington LED Streetlight program? Wayne Wentz, Chief of Transportation, Engineering and Operations for Arlington County will give a brief presentation about the switch to LEDs at our next General Membership Meeting (Thursday, April 19, at 7:30 p.m.). There also will be an opportunity for you to raise any questions or concerns you may have about streetlights.

As you may have heard, Arlington County plans to replace as many streetlights as possible with attractive, reliable, energy efficient models. The newer LEDs can reduce energy use, simplify repairs, and save money.

The Arlington-East Falls Church Civic Association already has one approved and funded streetlight project initiated several years ago through the Neighborhood Conservation program. A map with proposed streetlight placements was made available to homeowners and comments are under review.

A new Farmers Market is expected to open Sunday, May 6 in Westover. It will be a local producer's market with a strong emphasis on fresh food, and will offer fruits, vegetables, meats, dairy products, breads, and other baked goods.
